MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 1989
LANIER PLAZA HOTEL
ATLANTA, GEORGIA

The meeting of the elected officers was called to order by President Heater at 10:00 PM. All were present except Region I Vice President Jack Pasquale, who had not yet arrived in Atlanta.

Guests present were Mentors Editor Mike Harris, US
JCI Senate Foundation President Bill Miller, and Future
Directions Committee Member, Newton Standridge.
Mike Harris reported on the first issue of MENTORS:
6450 copies were mailed at a total cost of about \$5100 .
Advertising revenue for this issue is estimated at
about \$500. Photographs are needed from the various
meetings and activities to accompany articles. The
deadline for the December issue is October 15. Mike's

Bill Miller, Foundation President, reported on the Foundation's activities and program. President Heater emphasised the need to support our Foundation by the entire Senate, and especially the Executive Committee. President Heater discussed tomorrow's meeting, noting that the Regional presentations will begin with Region X, and proceed through Region I. Written Reports will be required of all Vice Presidents with verbal comments mainly to supplement the reports.

A discussion was held regarding the condition of the various Regions and States. Particularly focused upon was the problem of how best to support those States who could use help from the National Organization, and how to get Mentors into the hands of Senators in problem States.

the proposed 1989-1990 budget and year to date tabulation of Income and Expenses through August 31, 1989.

Secretary Charles Gouveia reported that three Senate Scenes have been published so far, and the Directory is also now available. The Constitution Bylaws and Policy, as well as the Senator's Guide should be out soon.

Administrative Vice President Marty Tuohy reported on administrative matters, Directory corrections, and reports for tomorrow's meeting. President Heater reported on the committee which is working on the revised Senator eligibility guidelines for proposal to the US Jaycees, they will report to the entire Board tomorrow. All Senate groups are to cooperate with the wishes of their State Jaycee President regarding Senatorship applications.

The meeting was ajourned at 11:30 PM.
