Executive Committee Meeting January 14, 1994 Tulsa, OK

Meeting called to order by President Joe Eller at 9:20 PM

President Joe updated everyone on the Hong Kong policy. He outlined the events of the past few days and some conversations and meetings that took place in Tulsa. He has called a meeting at 10PM of elected officers and Foundation Trustees to discuss this further. Joe asked for questions and comments. Treasurer's Report - Don Robertson. Don went over membership by regions. Four states haven't submitted dues kits. He will close the books this weekend. Don also went over the balance sheet and budget. The budget is pretty close to schedule. He is concerned about MENTORS income - only 1/4 way to goal after two issues published. EXPENSES - Finance Committee recommends having a Tussell (sic) with Russell fund of \$2000 to be taken out of general contingency. This will be a special line item in budget. (M) Robertson (S) Ashley Motion passes. Fin Comm also recommends the stein project. We will order a minimum of 1000 steins. Anheuser-Busch will purchase 324 and the Senate will purchase 676 at \$17 each (\$15 for stein, \$1.48 for artwork, \$.50 for shipping to Kiefer). We will sell them for \$25 plus \$3.50 postage.
